Services Provided:

ADDICTION TREATMENT

■ Tribal Health recipients meet with experienced Behavioral Health staff for a range of support in meeting their addiction treatment needs. Areas of focus include addiction treatment for substances and gambling, including therapy for adolescents and adults.

A number of options are offered for recipients seeking recovery:

- Chemical dependency assessment
- Outpatient counseling and brief treatment for addictions
- Addiction treatment groups
- Medically assisted chemical dependency treatment
- Crisis intervention services

MENTAL HEALTH

- Tribal Health recipients have the opportunity to access professional mental health services from qualified clinical staff. Services include:
- Mental health evaluation
- Psychological assessment
- Adult psychotherapy
- Child and adolescent psychotherapy
- Family therapy
- Couples counseling
- Crisis intervention services
- Chronic pain group
- Anger management group
- School-based counseling available in the Ronan and Arlee school districts

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

- Addiction Treatment and Mental Health programs offer walk-in appointments. The following services are also provided to recipients:
- Referrals to in-patient care
- Domestic violence program
- Suicide prevention program
- Special Olympics partnership
