Elmo to Big Arm State Park Trail Project

Project Elements:

Phase I of the Elmo to Big Arm State Park Trail Project will provide safety improvements and be a new network of multimodal connectivity for the town of Elmo. The trail extends from the Elmo Community Center to Kupawigquk Picnic & Swimming Area. The north end of the trail connects members of the community to one another, improves connectivity to the Standing Arrow Pow Wow Grounds, and provides Highway 93 crosswalk safety improvements. The south end of the path provides a walk along the majestic Flathead Lake and the breathtaking Mission Mountains, with a phased ending at the heavily used Kupawigquk Picnic & Swimming Area.

Key aspects of the project include:

- Constructing approximately 3,320 lineal feet of new 8' wide accessible asphalt trail
- Installing 1,900 lineal feet of new concrete landscape retaining wall along Flathead Lake
- 2 new rapid flashing, pedestrian activated, crossings with advanced warning
 - Crossing at Standing Arrow Pow Wow Grounds Intersection
 - Crossing at Elmo Fire Department Intersection
- New trail signage and trail wayfinding
- New pavement markings and ADAcompliant crosswalk ramp improvements
